

Conference Overview

"How we are welcomed into this world matters and influences us for the rest of our lives. Birth Psychology is a field of study that explores the lifelong impact of our earliest conscious awareness beginning in the womb. Our pregnancy, birth, and attachment experiences have an ongoing and cascading effect on shaping our adult lives. These foundational relationships, in turn, impact our world in a profound way." OBJECTIVES

- Participants will define birth psychology and principles that nurture human potential and optimize relationship from the beginning.
- Participants will discuss their role in babies' narratives from preconception through the postnatal period.
- Participants will discuss the prenatal mental life of mothers intending to relinquish their babies and of the babies lying inside, waiting to be relinquished.
- Participants will discuss the learning capabilities of babies in the womb and the value of parents reading to them in the womb.
- Participants will describe the sentience of our babies in the womb and how the mother's mental state and regulation can improve the outcome of the baby's challenges.
